### Rules:

- The 2010 PAEP Photo Contest is open to all general, associate, and student members of PAEP in good standing. Each member can submit up to two (2) photos in each category. Submitted photos must be titled. Photos must have been taken by the entrant of subjects within the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. Photo location and subject must also be identified when submitted.
- All photos should accurately reflect the subject matter and the scene as it appeared. Photos that have been digitally altered beyond standard optimization will be disqualified.
- Photos must be submitted digitally in a .jpg file format. Photos should be no smaller than 5 x 7 inches at 72 pixels/inch. File size cannot exceed 2 MB.
- Entrants retain ownership and other rights to their images, except that permission is granted to PAEP for limited use and contest promotional rights.
- The Board of Directors will review the submitted photos, identified only by their photo title, and select no more than five (5) finalists in each category. Finalists will be notified following the Board selection. Attendees at the PAEP Annual Conference on Wednesday and Thursday (May 12-13, 2010) will review the photos, identified by only their photo title, and vote for the winner in each category from the finalists, as well as for a Best Overall Photo.
- Winners of each category and Best Overall Photo will be announced on Friday, May 14, 2010 at the conference. Winners will receive a special PAEP gift and have their winning image featured on the PAEP website and in the PAEP newsletter.
