Hess Energy Corp: Demand Side Response Presentation

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PAEP P2E2 RT 1st Quarter Meeting/Demand Side Response Presentation at PAEP Pollution Prevention Roundtable (PAEP), Tobyhanna, Monroe County. Members of the Pennsylvania Association of Environmental Professionals Pollution Prevention and Energy Efficiency Roundtable (P2E2 RT) met at the Tobyhanna Army Depot (TYAD). Hess Energy Corporation discussed their Demand Side Response Program. Discussions centered on curtailment programs where companies earn guaranteed income by lowering energy usage during periods of high stress on the grid.

TYAD presented a case study depicting the thousands of dollars in savings realized by participating in such a program. TYAD then hosted a tour of the depot's pollution prevention and energy efficiency projects and industrial areas. Technologies included solar tube lighting and a 100,000 square foot green roof. The Depot has an award winning environmental program that includes pollution prevention, energy efficiency, hazardous materials management, contamination remediation and maintenance of natural resources.

The Depot was a founding member of the Roundtable and hosted the first northeast regional P2E2 RT meeting in 1996. Members of Luzerne County Community College's JobTrakPA Program attended the meeting. Programs in LCCC's JobTrakPA include Solar Photovoltaic Installers and Electrical Construction and Technology. In addition, the OPPEA Manager provided an update on the CNG Grant Programs. Dupont borough attended this event specifically to hear about the grant update.
