The Planning Committee will select and notify presenters in May. Selected presenters will then submit a signed agreement provided by the PAEP office to confirm their arrangement. Presentations should be 45-50 minutes in length including time for Q/A from the audience. If you need more time, please let us know as we may be able to accommodate this.
