The application requires all of the following information...

- Title of Presentation
- Environmental Topic: (*choose any that are applicable from list above or write in your own*)
- Brief Summary of Presentation (*Please provide a brief summary [up to 250-words] of what the topic will cover/include. This description will be used in the conference program, and if your presentation is selected, it may also be used to help promote the conference.*)
- Learner Outcomes
- Primary/main Presenter Name and organization/contact information
- Additional Presenter(s) Name(s) and organizational/contact information.

Note - Due to continuing education credit processes, all sessions must be a minimum of 60 minutes which includes time for Q/A.

The deadline for submissions is **Monday, April 15, at 6:00 pm (ET)**. Please get your presentation ideas in as soon as possible. Abstracts received after this date may not be considered. The Planning Committee will select and notify presenters in mid-to-late May. Selected presenters will then be required to submit a signed agreement provided by PAEP to confirm their arrangement. Presentations should be 35-40 minutes in length plus 5 minutes for introductions and 15-20 minutes for Q/A from the audience. If you need more time, please let us know as we may be able to accommodate this.

REGISTRATION / EXPENSES: If you will only be attending the session at which you are presenting, then there is no registration fee to participate. If you wish to attend for the day or entire conference, then a nominal speaker fee will apply to help PAEP cover the cost of food and beverage.
